

Rundale Palace – Hill of Crosses (Lithuania, LT)

Rundale Palace with Charming French-style park is one of the most outstanding monuments of Baroque and Rococo art in Latvia, was built Duck Biron in two periods, from 1736 until 1740 and from 1764 until 1768, as Russian Empire Catherine II summer residence. Rundales Palace architect is Bartolomeo Rastrelli, created paintings on the ceilings and walls while sculptor Johann Michael Graff from Berlin made stucco decorations on a background of artificial marble.

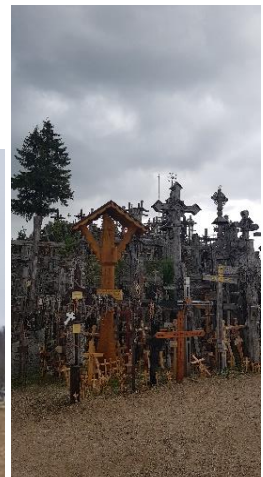
Hill of Crosses in Lithuania is a unique sacral place. People of different nations and religions bring here crosses with their names, intentions, and pleadings for clemency.
